Caterpillar Cotton Throw

This simple but beautiful, drapey, light-weight throw is woven using just one cone of our new Caterpillar Cotton yarn from Ashford!

What You Need:

Loom: 24" (or wider) Rigid Heddle Loom

Reed: 7.5" dpi

Warp & Weft:

1@ cone Caterpillar Cotton (743 yds/200 gm)

Color: Choose from six vibrant colorways!

Here's How:

Total warp ends: 180

Total warp length: 6.5 feet (2.15 yards)

Width in reed: 24 inches

Finished width: 23 inches

Finished length: 72 inches

Warping: Warp the full width in Caterpillar

Weave Structure: Plain balanced weave

Weaving

Weave the full length of the warp using the balance of the yarn. Ensure you have a balance weave — when placing the weft yarn BEAT GENTLY with the reed. For the balanced weave you want 7.5 rows per inch of weaving.

Finishing

Remove from the loom and secure the ends with a zigzag stitch and hem. Wash in warm water with a little liquid soap (we prefer our new SOAK laundry soap) and lay flat to dry. Press with a hot iron if needed.

Wear It!

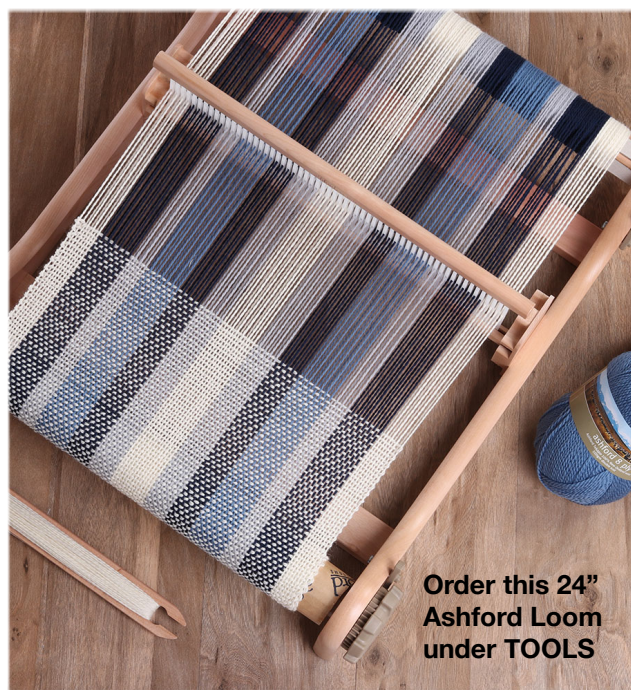
